WHEN, WHERE AND HOW:

THIS Saturday May 28th

Mountain Valley Neighborhood, intersection of Evening Star and Greenwood Drive Parade Arrival and Setup Time: 8:15am – 9am

EXPECTED WEATHER: Warm and Partly Cloudy (click the map for current conditions)...



Some clouds in the morning will give way to mainly sunny skies for the afternoon. High 88F. Winds S at 5 to 10 mph.

ENTERING PARADE CHECK-IN:

There will be an 8am 5K race from Round Hill Elementary to town the festival and back. Arrive in as few vehicles as possible from Evening Star Drive and E. Loudoun Street. Expect to be stopped just shy of the school when the road is closed. You will then be cleared to proceed down and across Main Street into the Mountain Valley by


a Fire Department member.

- Once at the Parade Start Check-In, you will receive a parade line number (non-negotiable) which is your spot in the line.
- Orange cones will be placed in parade section zones from 1 4.
- Your two digit number will tell you your zone (first digit) and your spot (second digit).
 You will be directed to your zone and assisted to your spot by a Fire Department member.



- Decorate in your spot, but ensure safety and a clean space when you leave.
- We will begin at 9:30am! So be ready to roll and not hold up the parade.
- · Remember to fill-up on fuel ahead of time J

UPDATED PARADE ROUTE WITH ENTRANCE FLOW INTO STAGING AREA:



A few more important ground rules to follow:

FOR RIDERS AND DRIVERS:

- If you haven't already, take some time to think about how you will decorate your vehicle with names and designs. Make it original and fun!
- Gather your group early and ahead of time into/onto your single vehicle. **There is no** parking available to do this near the parade
- The speed is SLOW and STEADY of course, as directed when starting.
- All vehicles must keep a 25 foot distance from the group ahead of you.
- Candy tossing is permitted as long as it reaches the curb, though EVERYONE must keep an
 active eye out for children running onto the route.
- Should there be reason to stop, anyone can call for a STOP by shouting and signaling an "X" with both arms.
- Ensure your passengers are secure on your ride at all times.
- Amplified music is allowed as long as it does not overpower other groups or the audience.

FOR WALKERS:

- Adults are permitted to engage with the crowd as they walk as long as this does not slow the movement of the parade. There is no passing, stopped or not, at any time.
- Children age 7 and older and in the <u>IMMEDIATE</u> company of an adult are permitted to walk. Adults with small children in wagons or strollers are also permitted.
- Candy tossing is permitted as long as it reaches the curb, though EVERYONE must keep an
 active eye out for children running onto the route.
- Should there be reason to stop, anyone can call for a STOP by shouting and signaling an "X" with both arms.
- All Animals must be approved by the Parade Director. Please do not bring animals without approval.
