- Designs should be 8½" x 11" (can be larger but will be reduced to approximately this size for printing). For this years' celebration, the contest is to fill in the inside of either to the "20th" designs on pages 2 & 3.
- All artwork must be original and will be reproduced on the T-shirts in full color.
- Do not include any text other than signing your work. We will incorporate the Hometown Festival logo into the design.
- Designs should be simple and use no more than three colors. Bright or dark colors work best.
- Use markers; crayons do not reproduce well.
- Keep in mind that this is a celebration around Memorial Day. Themes you may want to think about are "patriotic" or other images that you think embody Memorial Day.
- In the past, winning designs have usually been red, white and blue.

On the back of the design, please include:

- your name, age and grade
- your teacher's name (if you go to Round Hill Elementary)
- your parent's phone number and email address

Submit your original artwork to Mrs. Fink at Round Hill Elementary School or to the Round Hill Town Office on Main Street by Thursday, April 4, 2024. A winner will be announced on the Festival website by Friday, April 12, 2024.
